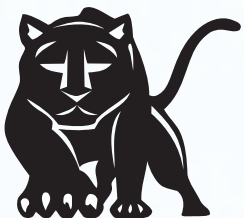

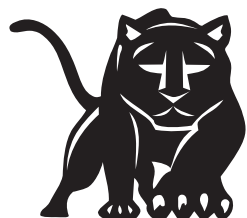

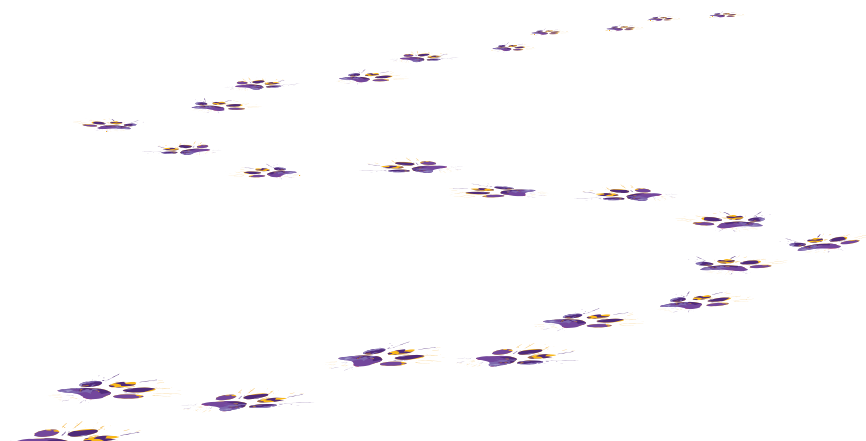

LEADERSHIP AWARD KURT GOLLNICK

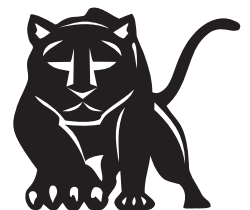

The Foundation is honored to call Kurt a loyal friend, generous supporter, and cherished member of this community.

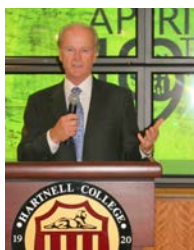
